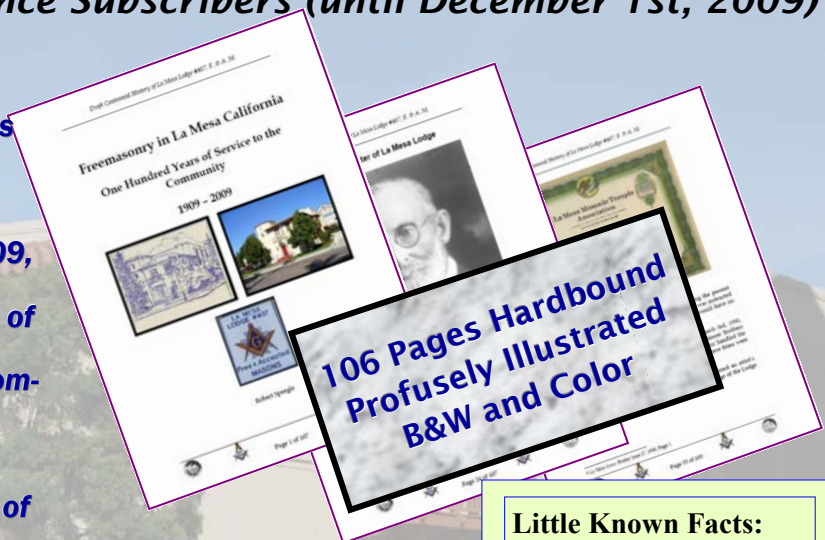


# La Mesa Masonic Lodge Centennial History 1909-2009
